Section – 3: Senior College (Under Graduate) Wing :

From the Academic Session:2024-2025, all UG (B.Sc./BCA/BBA/B.Voc.)First Year admissions, along with the monitoring of Teaching, Learning, and Evaluation processes, will be governed by the State Government's directions under the NEP-2020 guidelines.

The syllabus and implementation scheme, as adopted, are based on the report approved by the Faculties in their meeting on April 22, 2024, and the Academic Council under section 12(7).

Note :

(1) Admission is as per the reservation policy of the Government.

(2) Two combinations of subjects are allotted to the students as per the merit list and availability of the subjects at the actual time of admission despite the subject combination mentioned in the application form by the applicant.

(3) In addition to the above two combinations of subjects (Group of two subjects), as per the Resolution of SGB Amravati University by the Hon'ble VC vide Sec 12 (7) of the MPU 2016 and Direction/Ordinance as approved by the Faculties in its meetings dated 22.4.2024, Academic Council under section 12(7), the students should select the subjects and activities like; Internship/ Co-curricular/Community Engagement, etc. from each vertical as applicable to earn the corresponding **Mandatory Credits** for completion of the level. (Ref: Table 2; Page No. A-1655 & A-1656)



(4) The student shall finalize his/her choice of selecting **One** subject as a **Major** and another as a **Minor** out of the group of two (Major/Minor OR Minor/Major) subjects chosen at the time of admission; after the Second semester. The Major & Minor so finalized shall remain the same till the end of the Sixth Semester.

- 3.2.3 Admissions are subject to the eligibility norms of the S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati.
- 3.2.4 At the time of admission students has to bring a printout of submitted application form alongwith the attested copies of following documents as well as the original documents for verification :

- 3.2.6 Applicants who have a break in education should submit a gap certificate in the form of a court affidavit stating the reason for the gap.
- 3.2.7 Applicants will be required to surrender the original copy of their School/College leaving certificate at the time of finalisation of admission.
- 3.2.8 Duplicate T.C. (Transfer Certificate) will not be entertained.
- 3.2.9 Admission will be provisional, subject to the approval of the University, and is liable to be cancelled at any time if the applicant has given false information, or University enrolment is not given to him/her.
- 3.2.10 Reservation of seats for candidates belonging to backward classes will be according to the government regulations and circulars.
- 3.2.11 All matters related to admission will be handled by the admission committee. Applicants are required to contact this committee during working hours as displayed on the Notice Board.

7.2 Academic Results :

SECTION - 8 : Rules & Regulations and code of conduct for students

- 8.1** Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
- 8.2** The last date of submission of application forms will be displayed on the notice board of the college.
- 8.3** The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case a student does not deposit fees by that date, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled.
- 8.4** Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees as per University rules.
- 8.5** No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
- 8.6** All new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the University. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time or on the date prescribed by the University. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.
- 8.7** Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indisciplined manner will be expelled from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents and/or guardians have read and concurred with these rules.
